

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE CLERK-TREASURER OF  
THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Minerva Park deems it necessary to increase the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer of Village of Minerva Park because of increased Human Resources responsibilities and increased requirements of the Clerk-Treasurer brought about by significant increases in personnel in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the salary of the Clerk-Treasurer was last set in Ordinance 03-2007;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio that:

- Section 1. The annual salary of the Clerk-Treasurer of the Village of Minerva Park shall be twenty-two thousand dollars (\$22,000) per year, payable monthly.
- Section 2. The five thousand dollar (\$5,000) increase in salary is to pay for additional human resources duties the Clerk-Treasurer is performing related to the swimming pool staff and the paid EMS staff, as well as other human resources responsibilities for existing personnel.
- Section 3. All prior ordinance(s) or resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this ordinance is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof, and the remainder of said ordinance(s) or resolution(s) not inconsistent with this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4. Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Minerva Park, such emergency arising from the need to compensate the Clerk-Treasurer for additional responsibilities. Wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and shall be in force upon its passage.
