

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE COLUMBUS REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY FOR A MUTUAL AID COMPACT BETWEEN THE COLUMBUS REGIONAL AIRPORT AUTHORITY AND THE MINERVA PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village of Minerva Park and its Police Department along with the Columbus Regional Airport Authority to provide more efficient police services to the citizens of their respective jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of these political subdivisions to provide for mutual assistance by interchange and use of their police department personnel and equipment;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Mutual Aid Compact with the Columbus Regional Airport Authority for the term of September 1, 2009 through August 31, 2012.
- Section 2. The Mutual Aid Compact is attached as Exhibit A and is made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.
- Section 3. All prior resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this resolution is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the Village of Minerva Park, such emergency arising from the need to have the contract signed and returned to the Columbus Regional Airport Authority by September 1, 2009. Wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and shall be in force upon its passage.
