

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CLERK-TREASURER TO ENTER INTO A WORKING AGREEMENT WITH THE FRANKLIN SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Village of Minerva Park to avail itself of grant opportunities for the Village’s water quality and environmental sustainability efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Soil & Water Conservation District offers assistance in improving Franklin County’s natural resources;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

- Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a working agreement for various services of the Franklin Soil and Water Conservation District, including but not limited to public education, outreach, stream corridor protection and management recommendations, and illicit discharge and detection for the term of \_\_\_\_\_, 2009 through \_\_\_\_\_, 2010.
- Section 2. The fees for such services, \$\_\_\_\_\_, are itemized in the Working Agreement attached as Exhibit A and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein.
- Section 3. All prior resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this resolution is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- Section 4. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
