

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A RANGE OF SALARY PAY FOR THE CHIEF OF POLICE  
FOR MINERVA PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO, AND  
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Minerva Park employs a Chief of Police in the Minerva Park Police Department; and

WHEREAS, to be more competitive with surrounding communities, it is now necessary to set a higher range for the salaried pay of the Police Chief of the Village of Minerva Park, to begin January 1, 2010;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Minerva Park, Franklin County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The salaried rate of pay for the Chief of Police for the Village of Minerva Park shall be between \$50,000 and \$70,000 per year, to allow the Mayor flexibility in the pay range for the Police Chief.

Section 2. Salary will be reviewed at the Chief's performance review each year.

Section 3. All prior resolution(s) or any part thereof, which is(are) inconsistent with this resolution is(are) hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof, and the remainder of said resolution(s) not inconsistent with this resolution shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Council hereby declares this to be an emergency measure necessary for the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of Minerva Park, such emergency arising from the need to continue quality police protection for the Village. Wherefore, this resolution shall take effect and shall be in force upon its passage.
