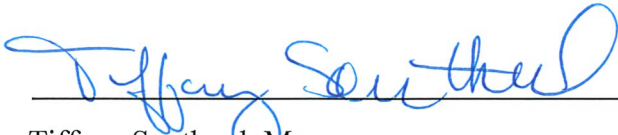
COUNCIL MEETING
