

ORDINANCE 35-2022

AN ORDINANCE TO RESCIND ORDINANCE 23-2015 EMS VEHICLE AND RELATED EQUIPMENT FUND AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 5705.13, Revised Code, allowed for the establishment of a capital projects fund for the purpose of accumulating resources for the acquisition of an EMS vehicle and related equipment; and,

WHEREAS, the fund and the balance in the fund are no longer needed for the purpose in which it was established.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MINERVA PARK, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Ordinance 23-2015 is hereby rescinded and the balance in the fund shall be returned to the General Fund from where it came.

Section .2 The Fiscal Officer shall transfer the fund balance upon passage of this ordinance and the appropriation of the funds.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, to be effective immediately upon passage, such emergency being necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare of the Village and its inhabitants, to wit: to have the fund rescinded and the transfer to occur as authorized in related legislation. Therefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage by the Council.
